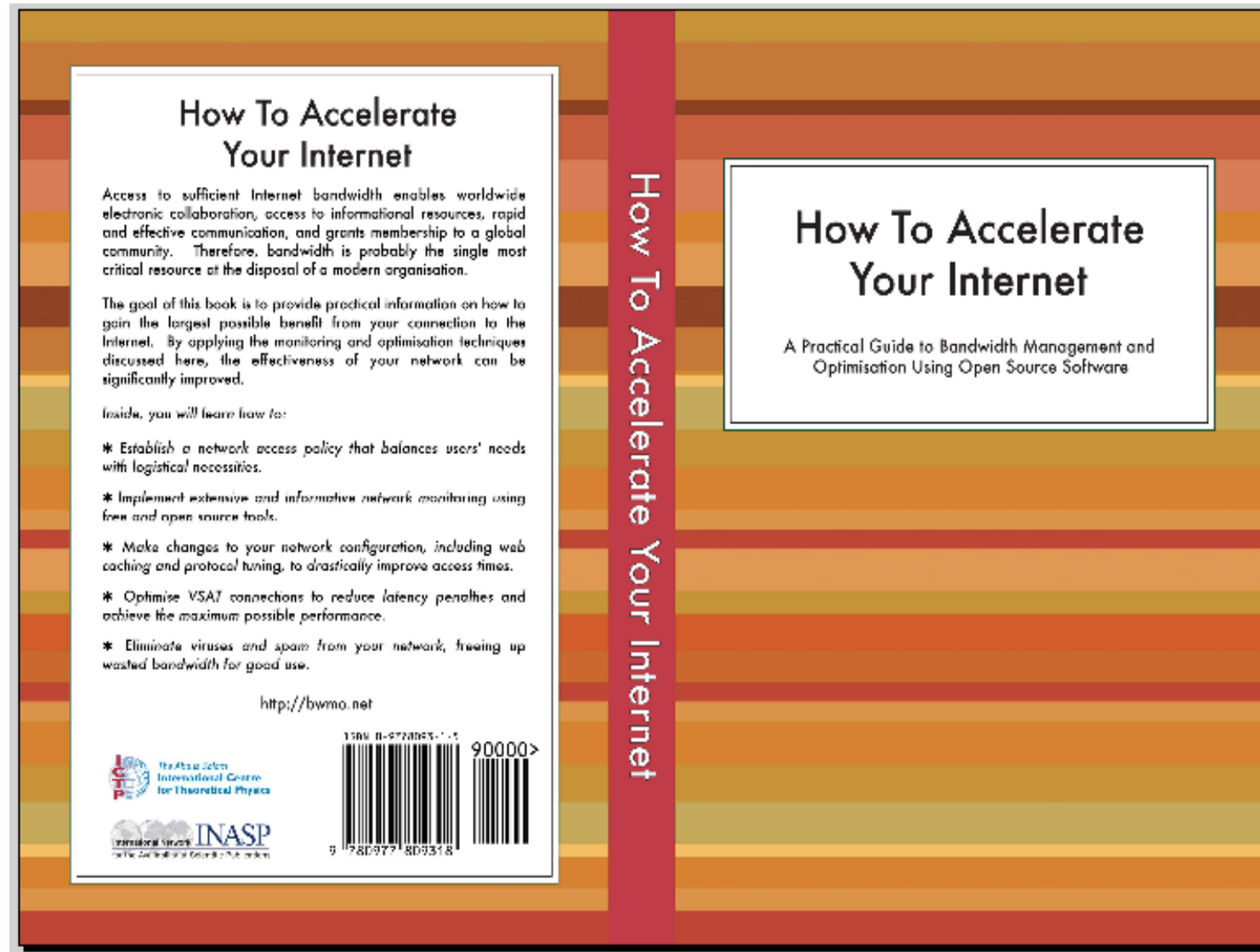

 - Books

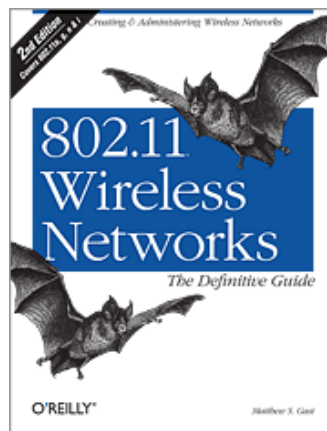
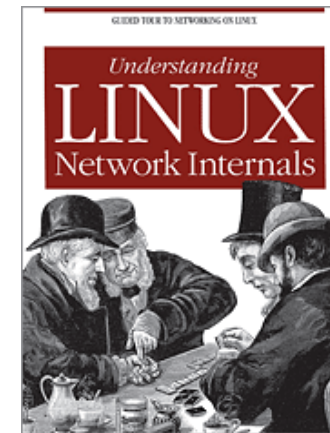
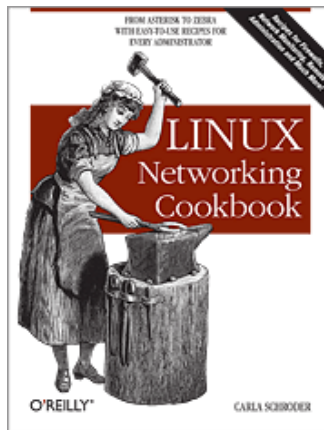
